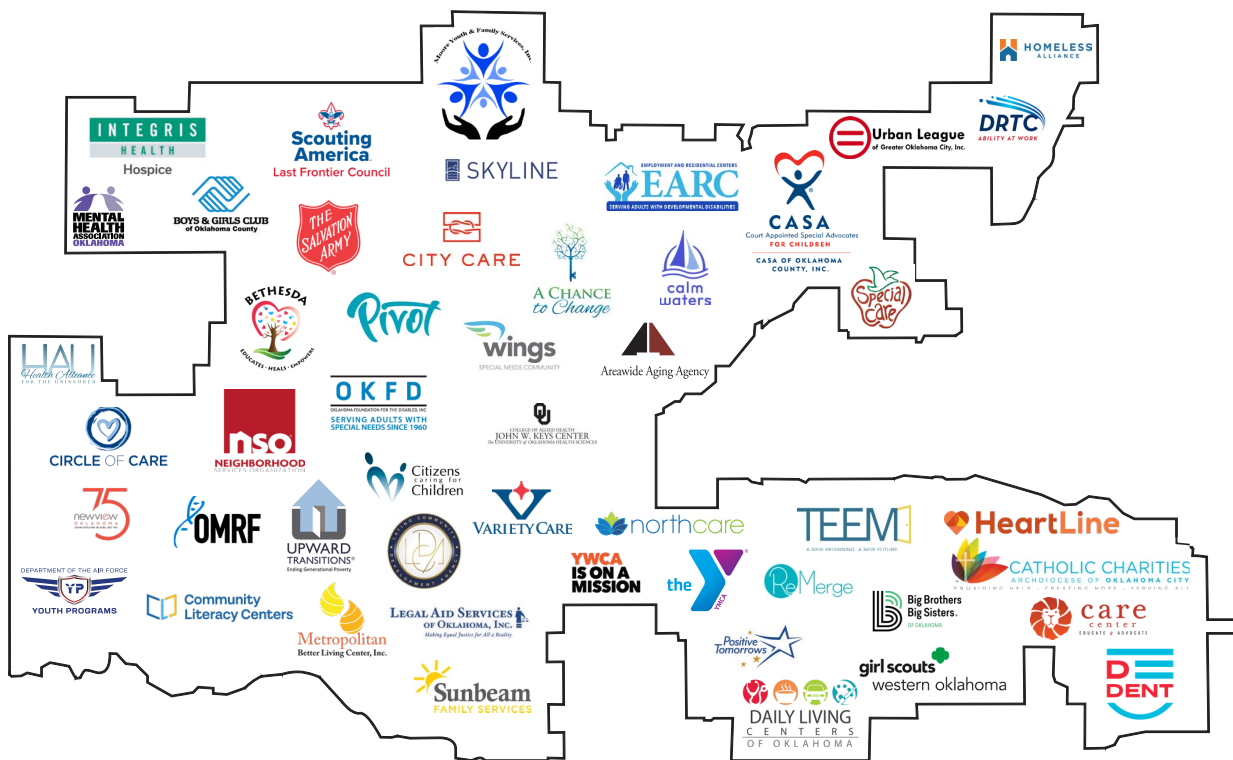

61,707 OKC metro seniors and/or adults living with disabilities are empowered through meaningful employment, personalized care, accessible transportation, and supportive services that honor their strengths and promote independence, purpose and inclusion.
