Our Partner Agencies are held to the same high standard and are evaluated annually during our volunteer-led Community Investment process. In 2025, **40 volunteers put in a total of 300 hours.**

THE PROCESS - YOUR DOLLARS AT WORK

01 RAISING FUNDS
United Way of Canadian County (UWCC) raises funds.

02 REVIEW OF AGENCIES
Community Investment (CI) donor volunteers review agency applications, budgets, audits, performance histories and program outcomes. They visit Partner Agencies to see firsthand the use of UWCC funds.

03 DECISION PROCESS
CI volunteers provide funding recommendations to the CI Committee, who will review and balance funding proposals from the volunteers for approval from UWCC's advisory board.

04 DISTRIBUTION OF FUNDS RAISED
Following approval, the funds are distributed among UWCC's Partner Agencies.

WHAT YOUR DONATION PROVIDES

\$2 per week ensures a foster child in Canadian County has the essential baby items needed for a safe and comforting start in their new home.

\$5 per week creates a safe and supportive space for a Canadian County child who has experienced abuse to share their story with a specially-trained forensic interviewer.

\$15 per month provides a full week of essential incontinence supplies for 12 Canadian County neighbors, supporting their dignity, comfort and well-being.

\$25 per month ensures a Canadian County family of four has access to meals and the stability that comes with knowing they'll be nourished every month.
