RAISING FUNDS

United Way of Logan County (UWLC) raises funds.

02

REVIEW OF AGENCIES

Community Investment (CI) donor volunteers review agency applications, budgets, audits, performance histories and program outcomes. They visit Partner Agencies to see firsthand the use of UWLC funds.

03

DECISION PROCESS

CI volunteers provide funding recommendations to the CI Committee who will review and balance funding proposals from the volunteers for approval from UWLC's advisory board.

04

DISTRIBUTION OF FUNDS RAISED

Following approval, the funds are distributed among UWLC's Partner Agencies.

WHAT YOUR DONATION PROVIDES

\$10 per week provides 520 healthy, nourishing meals to seniors in Logan County.

\$20 per month offers compassionate court support to empower Logan County children who have experienced abuse and their families.

\$50 per month provides 190 hours of respite care to full-time caregivers of a camper living with disabilities.

A one-time gift of **\$120** provides the necessary tools to efficiently manage high call and chat volumes during emergencies and information/referral surges for one 211 call specialist.
