902 Yukon youth are empowered with opportunities to explore their potential and develop confidence through leadership and personal growth experiences.

FINANCIAL SECURITY:

2,005 connections that empower Yukon residents to access food, clothing, safe housing, and vital resources to support their well-being during challenging times.

COMMUNITY RESILIENCY:

3,411 Yukon residents are supported and connected to local health and human services that promote healing, stability, and well-being during times of crisis through 2-1-1.
