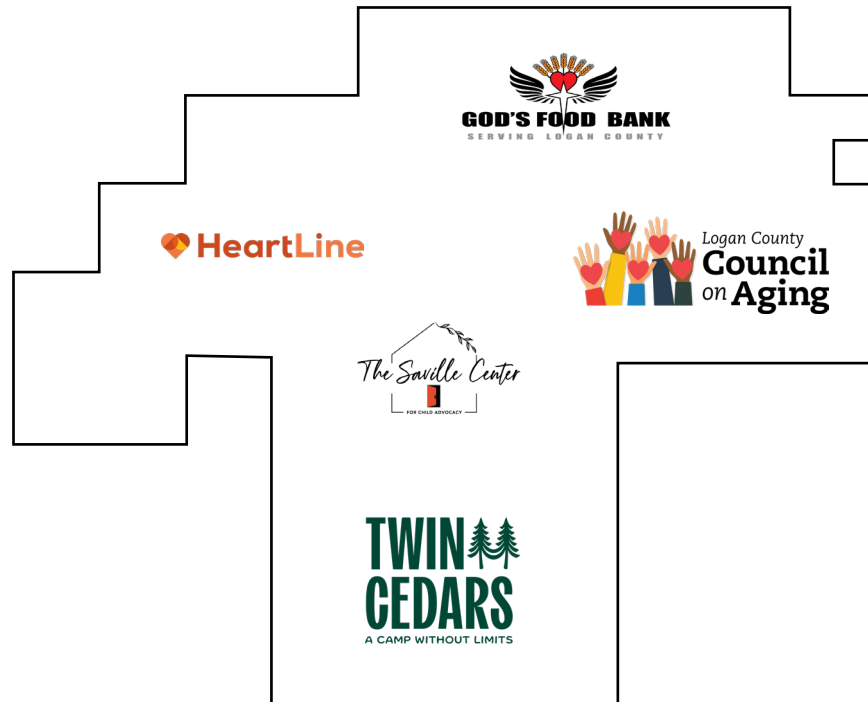

HEALTHY COMMUNITY:

63 Langston residents, including seniors, provided access to food and vital resources to help maintain their independence and dignity during challenging times.

YOUTH OPPORTUNITY:

11 Langston residents are compassionately connected to healthcare, counseling, and advocacy services that honor their dignity, support their healing, and promote overall well-being.

FINANCIAL SECURITY:

28 people living with disabilities and their families provided with an outdoor-oriented, safe haven camping experience through enriching activities.

COMMUNITY RESILIENCY:

45 Langston residents are supported and connected to local health and human services that promote healing, stability, and well-being during times of crisis through 2-1-1.
